

FALLS CREEK YOUTH CAMP 2022 IN-CABIN BIBLE STUDY FAMILY GROUP QUESTIONS

TUESDAY

SAVED: TRUST AND TAKE HOLD OF JESUS.

MAIN IDEA: We are SAVED from sin and reconciled to God when we put our faith in the gospel of Jesus by surrendering control of our lives to Jesus's already established Lordship. Our salvation glorifies God.

"So then, just as you have received Christ as Lord, continue to walk in Him, being rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, and overflowing with gratitude."

Colossians 2:6-7

FAMILY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Have you "received Christ as Lord"? If so, please share your story briefly.
2. Remembering that God's number one goal in all things is His glory, why do you suppose God requires those who want to be SAVED to repent of their sin?
3. The Holy Spirit shows us the sin in our lives. How is this a blessing?
4. Repentance leads to salvation and freedom, but we tend to resist it. Why? What does this reveal about us?
5. How can we pray for you today? *Spend time praying as a group.*

WEDNESDAY

SET APART: WALK IN OBEDIENCE AND COME AWAY FROM THE WORLD.

MAIN IDEA: When we put our faith in the gospel of Jesus by surrendering to His already established Lordship, we are SAVED by God to live SET APART lives with the help of the Holy Spirit. When we cooperate with the Holy Spirit, we glorify God.

“So then, just as you have received Christ as Lord, continue to walk in Him, being rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, and overflowing with gratitude.”
Colossians 2:6-7

FAMILY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Does the Holy Spirit live in you? How do you know?
2. How would our lives be different if we always did what God told us to do? Why don't we?
3. How has sin impacted you and/or those around you? Why do we continue to tolerate it?
4. How does holiness benefit those who pursue it? How does it benefit those around them?
5. What practical things can you do or stop doing to promote unity in your local church body?

THURSDAY

SOLID: SEEK TO BE LIKE CHRIST.

MAIN IDEA: As Christians, SAVED by God through faith in the Gospel to live SET APART lives, we must CHOOSE to develop habits that build the kind of SOLID faith that leads to obedience. Our obedience glorifies God.

“So then, just as you have received Christ as Lord, continue to walk in Him, being rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, and overflowing with gratitude.”
Colossians 2:6-7

FAMILY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Would you say you enjoy a true friendship with God? Explain.
2. Do you ever struggle to determine God's will for your life? Why or why not?
3. What practical things can you do to get to know God better?
4. What practical things can you do to improve your communication with God?
5. What practical things can you do to improve your relationship with your brothers and sisters in Christ for God's glory?

FRIDAY

SURRENDERED: GIVE YOUR LIFE TO GOD OUT OF GRATITUDE.

MAIN IDEA: We express our gratitude to God through obedience, but we must obey God with our minds before we can obey Him with our bodies. As Christians, SAVED by God to live SET APART lives, we must build a SOLID faith and stay SURRENDERED so God can glorify Himself through our obedience.

“So then, just as you have received Christ as Lord, continue to walk in Him, being rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, and overflowing with gratitude.”

Colossians 2:6-7

FAMILY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. How does what we think impact how we behave? Give examples.
2. What do you think God deserves from you? Do your actions prove this? Explain.
3. Are you more concerned with pleasing people or pleasing God? How does this impact your ability to express gratitude to God?
4. Would you say that you live to serve the gospel of Jesus? Explain. What, if anything, needs to change?
5. Why is it so hard to maintain an eternal perspective? What can you do to help yourself and others maintain an eternal perspective?
